General Information

Steps for Registering for a Field trip

Register for a field trip through completing the form on the registration page of this web site. You can mail or send the application by facsimile transmission to Photo Arts Santa Fe as described on the application. Upon our acceptance, we will reserve a place in the trip you select.

Your application to participate in a field trip is complete when we receive 1) the registration form 2) the appropriate fee 3) and the signed waiver of responsibility. The fee may be paid by credit card on this web site or by check. We reserve the right to cancel your reservation if PASF has not received your fee before your session start.

Cancellation Policy

If circumstances require you to cancel your attendance, these rules apply. For a one-day field trip, cancellation more than 5 days before the session's start, PASF will provide a full refund. Cancellation within 5 days of your sessions' start, we cannot refund your payment. For multiple day field trips, cancellation 30 calendar days prior to the start of the field trip, PASF will refund your monies. If cancelled within the 30 days prior, PASF will refund half your fee, or the entire fee if a replacement is found. If PASF must cancel a session, PASF will refund all fees. PASF will not be responsible for any travel arrangements made by you if your trip is canceled.

Instructor Change

Our instructors are working professional photographers who may have commitments preventing them from leading your session. We will attempt to arrange a suitable replacement and inform before your session starts.

Transportation at your session

Travel in and around Santa Fe for the field trips require a vehicle. PASF will not provide transportation to sessions. We ask each participant on the application if they will bring a vehicle and if they are willing to transport other members of their session. If yes, it allows fewer vehicles

on the road and a good chance for all to get to know each other. PASF bears no responsibility to provide or to assure the character of this transportation.

Travel Plans

Before you make long distance travel plans, check with PASF about the status of your trip. Santa Fe is one hour from the Albuquerque's Sunport International airport. A shuttle bus from the airport to Santa Fe leaves every hour. Contact Sandia Shuttle Express, 1-888-775-5696, 1-505-474-5696 or www.sandiashuttle.com for details. A reservation is advised for your day of arrival and day of departure.

Accommodations and Meals

We recommend certain motels next to each other for your stay. This allows PASF to arrange transportation for many with as few vehicles as necessary. Of course, you may make lodging plans at a place of your own choice. All meals are a personal expense.

What Do You Need

You will need a digital SLR, or a 35mm or medium format camera film camera. You must be familiar with your camera's operation, have its user manual, extra batteries and a tripod if you use one. Digital SLR users should have extra memory cards and a down load storage device or thumb drive. All film camera users must bring their own film.

Weather

Located at 7000 feet in a high desert, Santa Fe summers have daily high temperatures in the eighties and cool evenings in the high fifties. Light clothing and use of sun block is important. More important, is proper hydration. If you have a hiking water bottle, bring it. Buying water and refilling the bottle is advised. If you have special diet needs, let PASF know.
